## TOSCANO REZONE (CASE NO. RZ-21-0080)

A REQUEST TO REZONE APPROXIMATELY 20.9-ACRES FROM AGRICULTURE (A) TO AGRICULTURE RESIDENTIAL (AR) AT 22903 COUNTY ROAD 15-21, ELBERT.
