RESOLUTION 14 - 39

TO RESCIND APPROVAL OF SU 13-0010 PRESCOTT RANCHES WELL SPECIAL USE PERMIT REVIEW- A REQUEST TO RESCIND RESOLUTION 12-48, APPROVAL OF A SPECIAL USE PERMIT FOR AN OIL AND GAS WELL IN SEC 32, T 12, R 59.

WHEREAS, Mustang Creek LLC (hereinafter “Applicants”) received approval of SU 13-0010 to permit an oil and gas well for development of mineral resources; and

WHEREAS, approval was granted per Resolution 14-20 and contained 18 conditions of approval; and

WHEREAS, the location is in a portion of Section 32, Township 12 South, Range 59 West, in Elbert County; and

WHEREAS, the Applicants did not complete the conditions of approval within the required time frame, and did not request additional time to complete the conditions of approval; and

WHEREAS, the Applicants have instructed staff to allow the application to expire; and

WHEREAS, on September 10, 2014, a public hearing was held before the Board of County Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, having reviewed the documentation and recommendations by Staff, and having listened to all public comment, and being fully advised in the premise;



BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, the Board of County Commissioners do hereby RESCIND Resolution 14-20, SU 13-0010 Prescott Ranches Exploratory Well Special Use Permit.
