**RESOLUTION RESCINDING ANIMAL CONTROL RESOLUTION 99-44**


**WHEREAS**, on or about April 28, 1999, the Board of County Commissioners for Elbert County adopted Resolution 99-44, prohibiting dogs running at large, and providing for dog licensing and control in unincorporated Elbert County; and


**WHEREAS**, subsequent changes to the Colorado Revised Statutes have provided new and more specific definitions, have established new standards for pet animal control and licensing, have created conflicts between the statutory language and the County Resolution's language, and have called into question the enforceability of Resolution 99-44.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of County Commissioners for the County of Elbert, Colorado, that Resolution 99-44 is hereby rescinded in its entirety.


