RESOLUTION 15-<u>/8</u> CANCELLATION OF UNCOLLECTIBLE TAX ASSESSMENTS

WHEREAS, consistent with C.R.S. § 39-10-114(2)(a), the Board of County Commissioners has the power to cancel any taxes levied on personal property which are determined to be uncollectible after a period of one (1) year after the date of becoming delinquent; and

WHEREAS, consistent with C.R.S. § 39-10-114(2)(b), the Board of County Commissioners has the power to cancel any taxes levied on real property that is determined to be uncollectible after a period of six (6) years from the date of becoming delinquent; and

WHEREAS, the Elbert County Treasurer Richard Pettitt has requested the cancellation of certain tax assessments in accordance with the provisions of C.R.S. § 39-10-114; and

WHEREAS, having reviewed the documentation and recommendations presented by the Elbert County Treasurer, and having listened to all public comment, and being fully advised in the premise, the Board of County Commissioners has found sufficient evidence to support the cancellation of certain tax assessments from the County's assessment roll.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS FOR THE COUNTY OF ELBERT as follows:

- 1. Based on information provided by the County Treasurer, the Board of County Commissioners finds that the tax assessments for all accounts listed on Exhibit A, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, are uncollectible pursuant to C.R.S. § 39-10-114.
- 2. The tax assessments described in Exhibit A, which include severed mineral interests, a mobile home, and personal property, have been delinquent for the requisite statutory time period to be determined uncollectible and are now subject to cancellation by the Board of County Commissioners.
- 3. The tax assessments amounting to a total amount of Two Thousand Three Hundred Sixty-five and 25/100 (\$2365.25) dollars for all accounts listed on Exhibit A shall be cancelled and removed from the County Assessment Roll.
