**RESOLUTION 20-24
URGING SUPPORT FOR AMENDMENT C REGARDING CONDUCT OF
CHARITABLE GAMING**

WHEREAS, this amendment to the Constitution of the State of Colorado would decrease the number of years a non-profit entity must operate from five to three years prior to applying for a Bingo/Raffle license ; and

WHEREAS, the amendment also allows hiring, at no more than minimum wage people to manage and operate such games; and

WHEREAS, the Elbert County Board of County Commissioners recognizes the tremendous value of our local non-profit organizations to our citizens and communities; and

WHEREAS, the impacts of COVID-19 and other economic disruptions have impacted the revenue to many non-profits just at the time they are needed most;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE ELBERT COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ELBERT COUNTY, COLORADO officially declares its support of Amendment C as it can help alleviate the funding difficulties experienced due to COVID-19 and other business interruptions by newer non-profit organizations that support our county's citizens and make establishing new non-profit entities more feasible.
